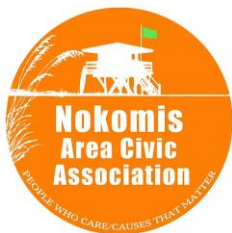
Building Community Understanding and Management of Nutrients for Healthy Water
