While we prefer that businesses/groups register for both nights, we realize that your time is precious. Please indicate when you will be attending.

You may set up your booth as early as 10:00am. We suggest all booths try to set up as early as possible, arrive no later than 6:30 PM to avoid being stuck in event traffic and locked out of the park. *PLEASE NOTE: All booth volunteers will need to arrive early. After 7:00 PM, no one will be admitted without a ticket to the event and you will be stuck in event traffic.

****All volunteers manning booths must sign in upon arrival and obtain a wristband to be worn during the event. Your wristband will be good for both nights. As this event is first and foremost a fundraiser, there will be a Maximum of 4 free people per booth, TOTAL (not per night) (names must be given to Dennis Bragg in advance or you may not be admitted). If you would like to have additional volunteers at your booth, you must purchase tickets for each person for a discounted fee of \$7.00 each to help cover the excess of revenue loss. Please coordinate the purchase of these discounted tickets with your organization and with the Trick or Treat Trail organizer, Dennis Bragg.**

Tips for Having a Booth

- **Get creative** with your decorations and solar or battery-operated lighting. **Lighting is essential.** Electricity is NOT available, but a small battery-operated lantern on your table will do the trick! Also, **think about having a fun activity** as part of your booth such as a game to win the candy or trinket you'll be handing out.
- **Feel free to promote** your business or group! Remember this is a great opportunity to advertise your organization and provide parents with coupons, samples, or items that promote your business/group! To keep foot traffic on the trail at a minimum, *the selling of items is prohibited.*
- **Provide trick-or-treat candy, goodies or trinkets.** We recommend you hand them out to each person to ensure that there will be enough for the whole night, both nights. Plan for approximately 1500-1700 people per night.
- **Have fun** and enjoy you time at Oscar Scherer!
